## *“GIS Research in Context”*

### Pre-Conference Workshop for GISRUK 2001

---

As in previous years, the GISRUK Steering Committee are pleased to announce the Young Researchers Forum (Pre-Conference Workshop for GISRUK 2001) will run from lunchtime on Tuesday, 17th April, through to lunchtime on Wednesday, 18th April. The event is sponsored by RRL.net, QMRG, AGI, and GISRUK.

The event is aimed at researchers just starting their academic careers; post-graduates; undergraduates who are keen to know more about research & GIS; and more experienced researchers or post-doctoral fellows who want to learn more about how to apply GIS in their domain. The event is jointly organised by Scott Orford (Cardiff), Peter Halls (York), David Unwin (Birkbeck), Robin Flowerdew (St. Andrews) and Nick Chrisman (Washington).

The programme will include seminars, panel discussions, and hands-on workshops. The aim is to give everyone a flavour of GIS research in different disciplines; learn about the hot topics in current GIS research; and to be introduced to new approaches for applying GIS in their own domain. The forum will be very informal, so there'll be plenty of opportunities to “ask the experts” and learn from their experiences. In addition, the forum will include the “Best Practice” sessions for new researchers (including paper writing, presenting conference papers, obtaining research and travel grants, etc.). The full programme will be finalised nearer the date, as some sessions will be geared up to the interests identified from the delegates' registration forms.

Attendance at the Young Researchers Forum is **FREE** to post-graduates and post-doctorates from **RRL.net** institutions, subject to a maximum of 2 people per Regional Research Laboratory. These bursaries also cover the first £50 of travel costs to the event.

For all other Researchers wishing to attend the Young Researchers Forum, the full registration fee is **£60**. This includes attendance at all sessions, tea and coffee refreshments, evening meal on the 17th April, en-suite bed and breakfast accommodation (17th April) and lunch on the 18th April. For those not requiring B&B accommodation, the fee is only **£35**.

Places are limited to a maximum of 50 delegates. The RRL.net places (up to a maximum of 22) are reserved. If non-RRL places are over-subscribed, preference will be given to those who also register for GISRUK 2001 and/or the order in which we receive applications.

RRL.net universities include Cardiff, Glamorgan, Lancaster, Manchester, Liverpool, York, Glasgow, Birkbeck, Ulster, Newcastle, and Leeds.
